Academy classes

\infty In-company English


Usually take place in the office of the client. Business clients tend to contract English teachers through agencies and the classes can be group or individual.



If you have a European passport, you'll be able to live, work and study in Spain with no visa for as long as you want.

If you don't hold a European passport, you'll need a visa to be here longer than 90 days.

STUDENT



To apply for a student visa, you'll need to be accepted Into a course and get together all the paperwork that your nearest consulate requires. It usually takes around two to three months to gather and submit all the documents and then receive your visa. Student visas can be for any duration, but if you're planning on being in Spain for longer than 6 months, you should apply for a year's visa, which can be renewed from Spain before your visa expires.

TtMadrid offers a year-long academic program, which allows students to apply for a visa. The program immerses you in the language and culture of Spain with an intensive program of Spanish classes and a range of cultural activities.
